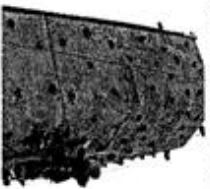

OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

THE 16TH ANNUAL MIGHTY VERMILION DUCK RACE

Sponsored by The Boys & Girls Club of Livingston County ("Presenter") a 501(c)(3) Corporation (tax exempt charity). Tax ID #17-0995574.

1. A maximum of 5,000 Rubber Ducks will be entered in the race.
2. Ducks will be launched into the Vermilion River at approximately 2:00 PM on Saturday, June 27, 2009. The race course will be established by the Presenter and will be approximately a 12-20 minute race.
3. All ducks entered will be provided by the Presenter and will remain property of the Presenter.
4. Once the ducks are launched, they are on their own. No attempt to free or interfere with any duck is permitted, unless deemed necessary by the Race Committee.
5. A number will be attached to each duck. Multiple Duck entries from one ticket will be assigned duck numbers for identification. The person's name who appears on the entry ticket corresponding to the first duck in order of finish will be awarded prizes. A list of prizes can be obtained from the Presenter by sending a written request therefore and a self-addressed return envelope to: The Mighty Vermilion Duck Race, Post Office Box 311, Pontiac, IL 61764.
6. Presenter reserves the right, at its sole option, to substitute prizes of comparable value.
7. The value of the prizes offered in the 2009 Duck Race are valued at \$11,000. Winners will be announced at 3:30 PM following the race. The prizes will be awarded as quickly as arrangements can be made.
8. The entry portion of each race ticket must be completely filled out and delivered to presenter or an authorized representative of Presenter or mailed to Presenter at the address set forth in paragraph five (5) above and actually received by Presenter prior to the race for a ticket to be eligible to win any prize. No other tickets are eligible to win any prize. Entrants assume the risk of responsibility of any entries to Presenter or an authorized representative of Presenter. Entrants must be 18 years old or older.
9. No purchase is necessary in order to enter or win. Presenter does encourage a donation of \$5.00 per entry to benefit the Boys & Girls Club of Livingston County, a charitable organization under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and other charitable organizations.
10. Free entry tickets offered for charitable fund raising purpose of the event and are not encouraged. However, one free ticket per person can be obtained by presenting a handwritten request therefore to the address listed in paragraph five (5) above and submitting therewith a self-addressed, stamped return envelope for mailing of the entry ticket. Requests for free entry tickets made after 5:00 p.m. on June 26, 2009 or after 5:00 ducks have been adopted will not be honored.
11. Winners will be announced at Humiston Riverside Park, approximately 90 minutes from conclusion of race on June 27, 2009. Entrants will, when necessary, be notified by United States mail or telephone. Race winners need not be present to win. If any race winner does not claim his or her prize within 30 days of race date, Presenter will select alternate winner through a random drawing of entry tickets. All prizes will be awarded.
12. Employees and their immediate families of the Boys & Girls Club of Livingston County are not eligible to win. Adopters must be 18 years of age or older and must prove eligibility.
13. No cash equivalent prizes will be provided in lieu of designated prizes. Any and all taxes and similar fees are the sole responsibility of the winner.
14. By entering, entrants release Presenter and its officers, directors, and staff and other related entities from any and all liability with respect to prizes.
15. By entering, a winner consents to the promotional use of their names and likeness without additional compensation.
16. Chances of winner depend on the total number of qualified entries.
17. This event is subject to all federal, state and local laws and regulations and is void where prohibited by law.
18. The order of the race, the determination of race winners, and the random drawing for additional prizes will be audited by a representative of an independent accounting firm. All decisions and interpretations of rules and regulations will be made by Presenter and its judges or final.
